Your are a private foster carer if:

You are looking after, or plan to look after, someone else's child under the age of 16 years (under 18 if disabled) for 28 days or more, either all at once or during any one year, and; you are not a close relative of the child, and; you do not have any form of parental responsibility for the child (ask a lawyer or Children's Services if you are not clear what this means).

What must I do?

If you are, or you plan to be a private foster carer, you must notify the local authority.

If you plan to privately foster a child, you must let the local authority know between 6 and 13 weeks before you take them into your home, unless it happens as an emergency.

If you have taken a child as an emergency, or only just found out that you are a private foster carer and the child is already with you, you must notify the local authority immediately.

What if I don't?

If you don't notify the local authority and you are later found out, you can be prosecuted and, if convicted, face a fine, or in certain circumstances, imprisonment.

How do I notify the local authority?

Ring 01724 296500 and explain that you want to notify someone about a private fostering arrangement. Alternatively, you can visit any of our Local Link Offices, or call in person to the Children's Services offices at Church Square House, Scunthorpe.

Whichever you do, you will be put in contact with a social worker, who will take some basic details from you.

You will then need to fill in a form notifying us officially, of the placement. We will send the form to you. You should complete it and send it back as soon as possible.

It is important that you make sure you let us know about any convictions you or your family may have had on the form that we send you.

If you have any trouble filling in the form, contact us on 01724 296500, or ask at your Local Link office for help.



What happens next

We will check with the police about any criminal records that you or any members of your household may have. We are usually only interested in convictions that may mean that you are unsuitable to look after someone else's child.

We will then call to see you and ask you further questions about your care of the child. Things like whether the child has a doctor, whether they go to school, whether he or she sees their parents, brothers and sisters are all important. We will also need to check that the child's accommodation is suitable and that you can meet their needs.

If we are happy about the placement we will tell you so.

Future visits

A social worker will continue to visit the child from time to time, to make sure all is well and to offer you or the child any help if they need it. You should know that the social worker must be allowed to see the child alone if they want to. It is an offence to refuse to let the social worker see the child if they have reasonably asked to do so.

What if I stop private fostering?

If you stop being a private foster carer for any reason, you must let us know within 48 hours of the child leaving your care. You can either telephone on 01724 296500, visit any of our Local Link offices, or call in person to the Children's Services office at: Church Square House, Scunthorpe. We will need to know where the child has gone to, why he or she left your care and a few other details.

Don't worry!

All we are concerned about is making sure that your child has the support he or she needs to thrive. We are here to help, not to snoop.
